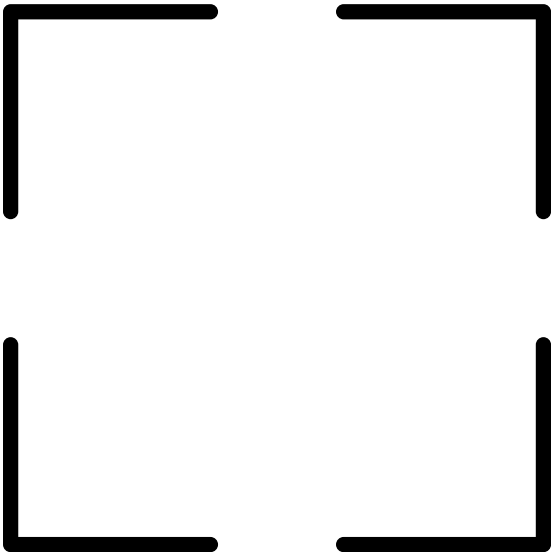

MEET THE CAST



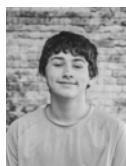

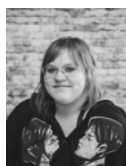
MEET THE CAST

I also want to say a very special thank you to the rest of the amazing production team and the many parents and others who came alongside the cast to bring the vision for this show to life.

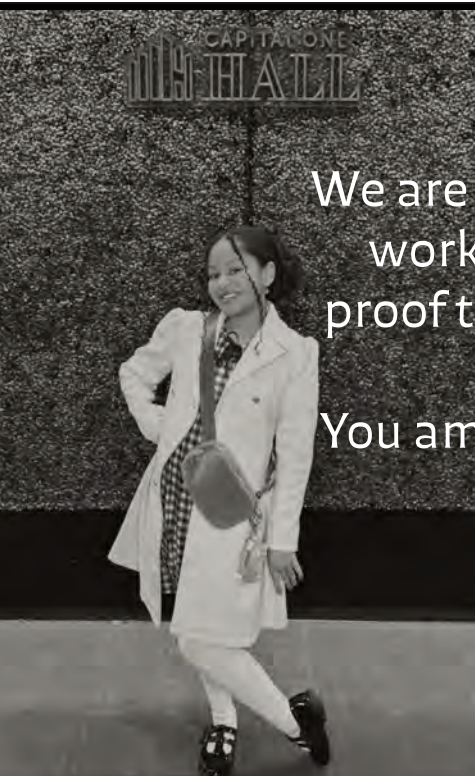
