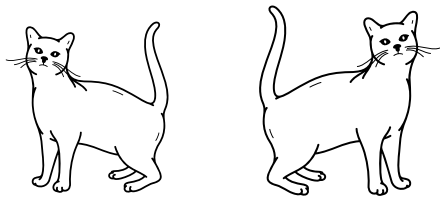
Rhys Hall

Youth Program Director

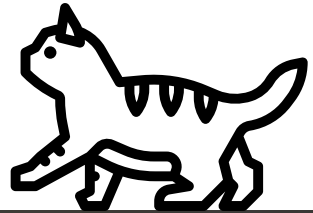

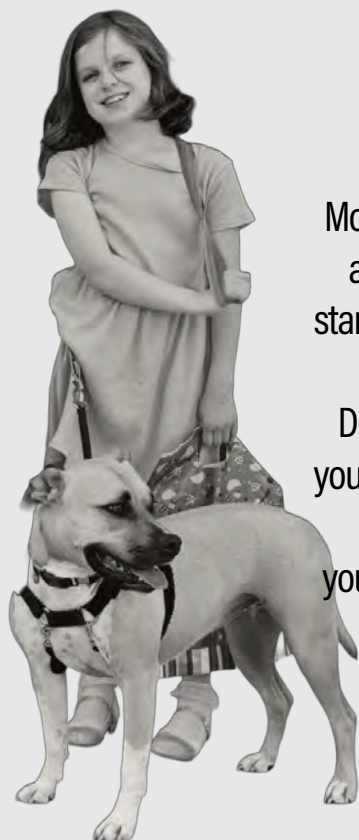
