FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE APOLLO CIVIC THEATRE

A Message From Our President

The "Miracle on Martin Street," is what a number of people have said about the Apollo Civic Theatre through the years. I would like you to think of it as not only a miracle for its continuous operation since it opened its doors on January 19, 1914, but as your community theatre/civic center serving you and the surrounding area. This building has seen Vaudeville, hosted a radio studio in the 30's, dances, a movie theatre, live theatre, concert venue, plus hosting the then unknown Garth Brooks in 1983, a community gathering place and much more.

It was great to see a YSTW Alumni, Christian Lopez, make his debut on the stage of the Grand Ole Opry.

On January 2nd, the Apollo welcomed our Executive Director Mary Cummings.

Our Youth Theatre Programs are full of activity with our 3 theatre camps, the Youth Summer Theatre Workshop (YSTW) grades 4th through 12th, and our Fall and Winter's Junior program, grades 1st through 12th and Kid's program grades K through 5th along with our season shows that are in full swing.

Thanks to a grant from the CVB we have a bright new projector so lookout for more films being shown at the Apollo. In our concert series we have Twitty and Lynn plus Lee Dean returning to the Apollo.

Checkout our website for more information and in this playbill for our upcoming season, special events and concerts.

We continue to make improvements in the theatre. We thank the City of Martinsburg for providing us funding for painting the exterior and some emergency brick work, and to the Berkeley County Commission for funding the Marquee replacement. The marquee is being fabricated in the Wagner Sign Company in Ohio. We will have a big celebration once it's installed.

We are continuing our architectural assessment which was funded through the West Virginia Culture and History's State Preservation Office. This report will provide us with a plan for renovating and improving the facilities thus allowing more programming, accesses to the building and additional rentals. As we work through getting funding for this project, we continued in putting a fresh coat of paint on the building. Along with the bright Martin Street Corridor we have remodeled our outer and inner lobby along our concession area and ladies restroom.

Senator Manchin secured the Apollo \$500,000 with 50% matching funding that we must secure. This money will be used on exterior masonry work along with renovations on the inside.

We like to get the word out of what is happening at your theatre so please contact us if you'd like us to make a presentation to your club or organization about the Apollo. We would like to thank all of the volunteers, sponsors and financial supporters who've contributed throughout the years and while we were closed. Your financial donations go to improving the equipment used in our productions along with maintenance and repairs on the building. Thanks to all who participated in the West Virginia Neighborhood Investment Program Tax Credits.

We hope to see you at not only this production but the productions and special events throughout the year and hope you bring your friends to "Get Into The ACT".
