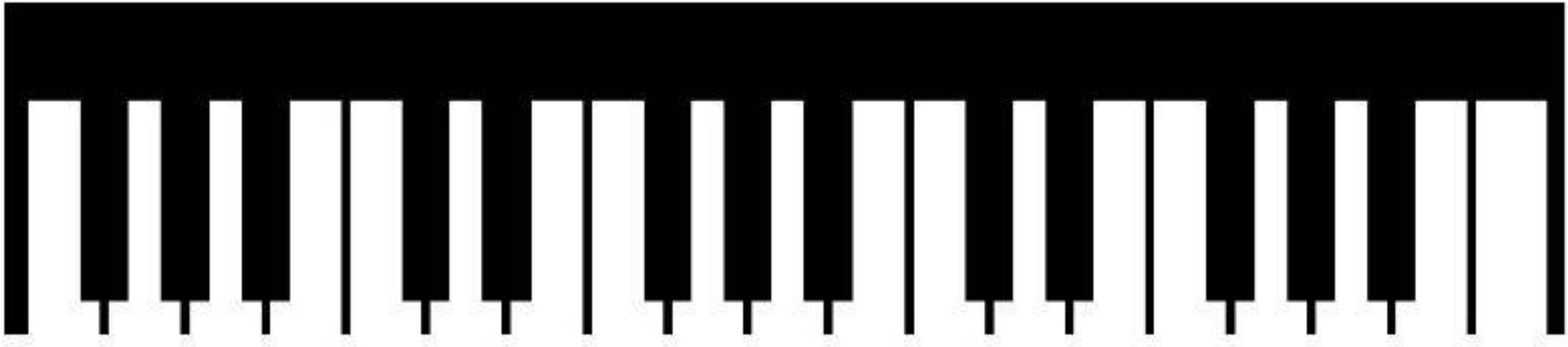
Jessica Bewley

WE NEED YOUR SUPPORT!

Did you know the cost of putting on a production?

- Royalties for a show can cost as much as \$8,000
- The set for a musical can cost as much as \$2,500
- Costumes for a production can cost as much as \$2,000
- An orchestra can cost as much as \$3000

Did you know the cost of maintaining the Apollo Civic Theatre?

- Utilities can cost an average of \$20,000 per year
- Repairs and maintenance can cost an average of \$20,000 per year
- Insurance can cost \$12,000 per year

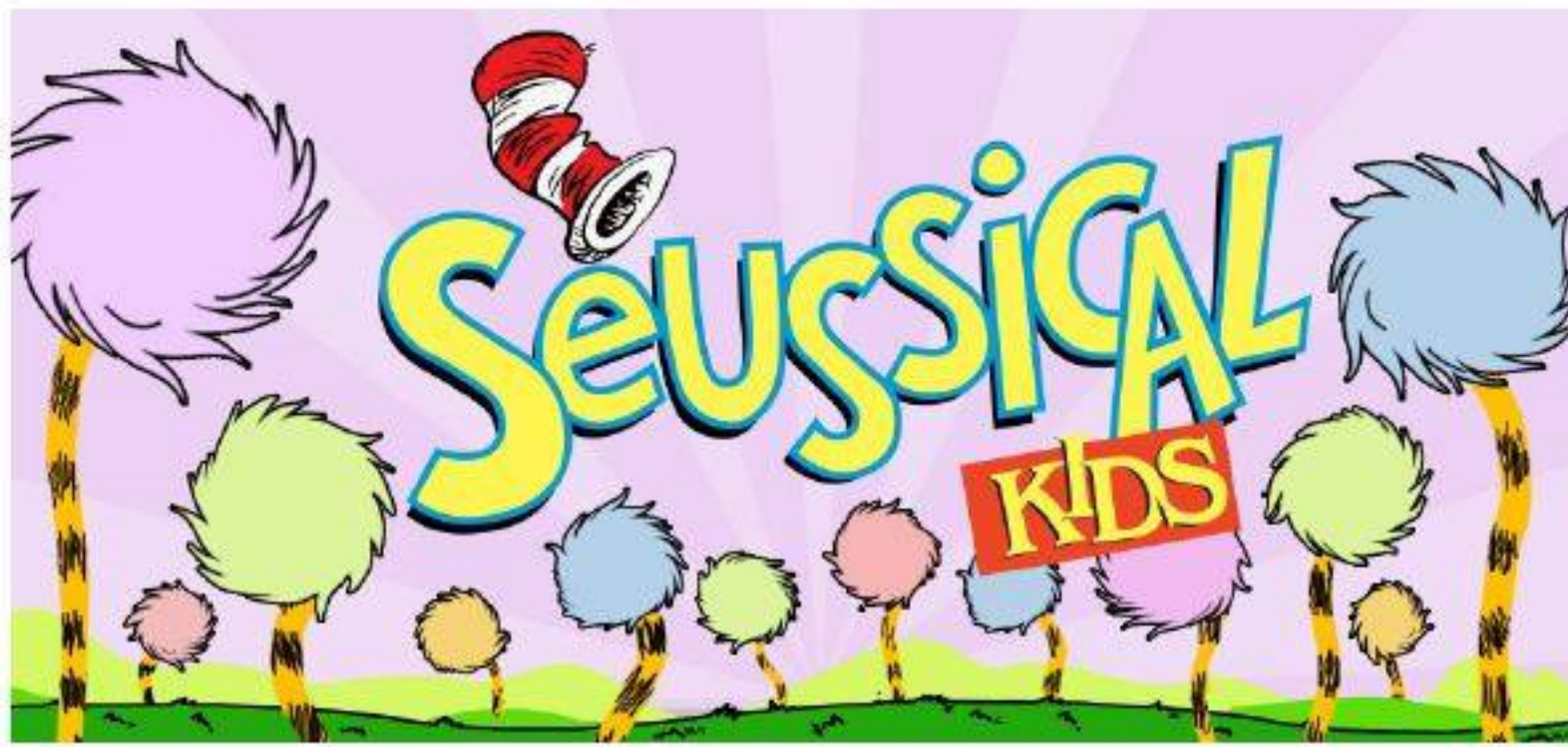
