I look forward to the possibility of working together to cultivate a thriving artistic environment in our community.

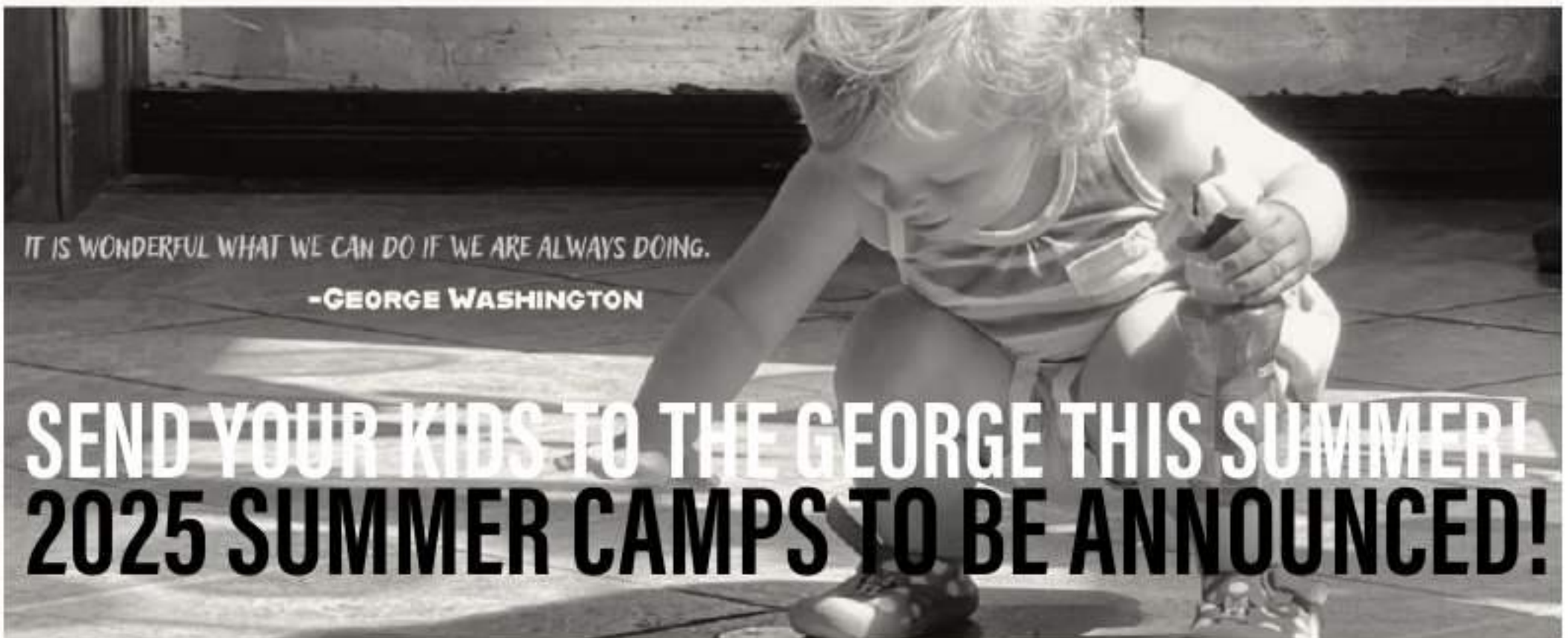
