FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE APOLLO CIVIC THEATRE

The "Miracle on Martin Street," is what several people have said about the Apollo Civic Theatre through the years. I would like you to think of it as not only a miracle for its continuous operation since it opened its doors on January 19, 1914, but as your community theatre/civic center serving you and the surrounding area. This building has seen Vaudeville, hosted a radio studio in the 30's, hosted dances, been a movie theatre, live theatre, concert venue, plus has hosted the then unknown Garth Brooks in 1983. It's been a community gathering place and much more.

On March 16, 2020, the theatre went dark and for the first time since 1980 and was shut down for 2 years. We returned with our Youth Theatre Company shows and workshops. The Youth Summer Theatre Workshop (YSTW) production of "SpongeBob, the Musical" was followed by our modified season shows as well as our fall and winter after school youth programs. We also introduced our new "Just for Kids" workshop during our winter after school program. This program is for kids in grades kindergarten through 5th grade. Just for Kids will join our Junior Program in the fall and winter.

As always October means Apolloween at the Apollo!

The "Haunt" and our free movie "Hocus Pocus" as well as Paranormal Investigations and the "Rocky Horror Picture Show" all fill our Apolloween festivities.

Checkout our website for more information and read through this playbill for our upcoming season, special events and concerts.

We continue to make improvements in the theatre. We thank the city of Martinsburg for providing us funding for painting the exterior and emergency brick work. Thank you to the Berkeley County Commission for funding the marquee replacement. The marquee is being fabricated in Ohio by the Wagner Sign Company. We will have a big celebration once it's installed.

We are continuing our architectural assessment which was funded through the West Virginia Culture and History's State Preservation Office. This report will provide us with a plan for renovating and improving the facilities thus allowing more programming, access to the building and additional rentals. As we work through getting funding for this project, we continued in putting a fresh coat of paint on the building. With the bright Martin street corridor and our remodeled outer and inner lobby nearing completion, we are now renovating our concession area.

Senator Manchin secured the Apollo \$500,000 with 50% matching funding that we must secure. This money will be used on exterior masonry work along with renovations on the inside.

We like to get the word out of what is happening at your theatre so please contact us if you'd like us to make a presentation to your club or organization about the Apollo. We would like to thank



all of the volunteers, sponsors and financial supporters who've contributed throughout the years and while we were closed. Your financial donations go to improving the equipment used in our productions along with maintenance and repairs on the building. Thanks to all who participated in the West Virginia Neighborhood Investment Program Tax Credits. We will have credits again this year.

We hope to see you at not only this production but the productions and special events throughout the year and hope you bring your friends to "get into the ACT".

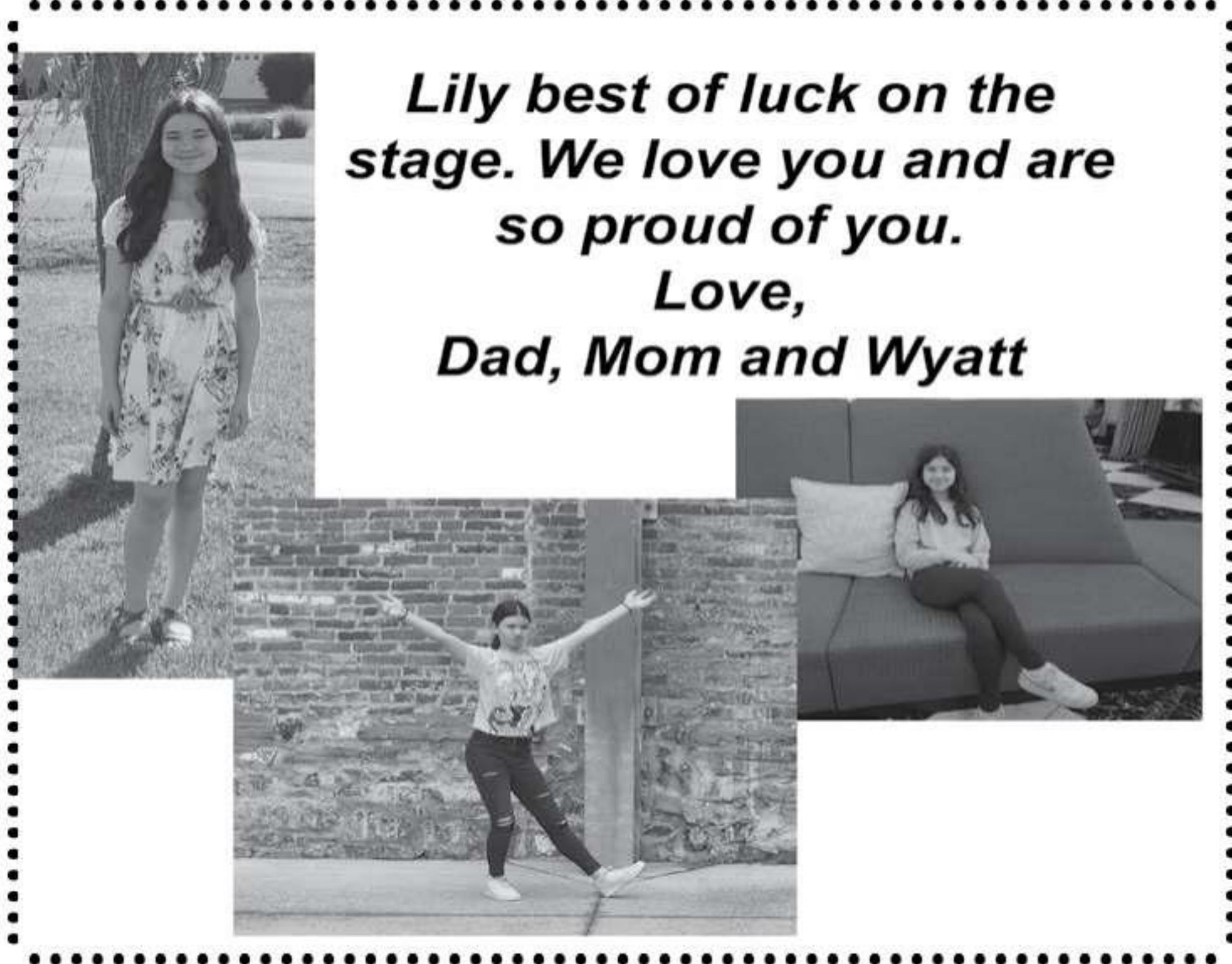

Dennis Kelly: work for theatre includes Debris, Osama the Hero, After the End, Love and Money, Taking Care of Baby, DNA, Orphans, The Gods Weep, and The Ritual Slaughter of Gorge Mastromas. He has written the book for the new musical of Pinocchio which opens at the National Theatre at the end of 2017, and in 2018 his new play Girls and Boys opens at the Royal Court. His plays have been performed worldwide and to date have been translated into nearly forty languages. For television he co-wrote and co-created Pulling and wrote and created Utopia, and for film he wrote the screenplay for Black Sea, directed by Kevin MacDonald. He also wrote the book for the Olivier and Tony winning Matilda the Musical. In 2010 DNA became a set text on the GCSE English Literature syllabus.

Tim Minchin: is a musician, actor, comedian, writer and director. He's toured extensively in the US, UK and Australia, performing solo, with bands, and with symphony orchestras. He's released five DVDs, the most recent recorded with the Heritage Orchestra at the Royal Albert Hall. Screen acting credits include Robin Hood Origins (2018), Secret River (2015), and Californication (Season 6 - 2013). Stage acting credits include Rosencrantz and Guildenstern are Dead (Sydney Theatre Company) and Jesus Christ Superstar (UK/Australia tours). Tim has written extensively for theatre, and is the composer-lyricist of Matilda the Musical (with Dennis Kelly) and Groundhog Day the Musical (with Danny Rubin).

Roald Dahl: Roald Dahl (1916-1990) was the author of Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, Matilda, The BFG and many more of the world's best-loved children's stories. He remains one of the world's greatest storytellers and is celebrated annually by the world's biggest author-based event, Roald Dahl Day – which is recognised across the globe on 13th September.

His first children's story, James and the Giant Peach, published in 1961 and was a huge hit. Every subsequent book became a best-seller.

Today, his stories are available in 59 languages and, by a conservative estimate, he has sold more than 250 million books. Many of these stories have also been adapted for stage and screen, including the 1971 film classic Willy Wonka and the Chocolate Factory, Wes Anderson's acclaimed Fantastic Mr Fox, and the Royal Shakespeare Company's multi-award winning production of Matilda The Musical.
